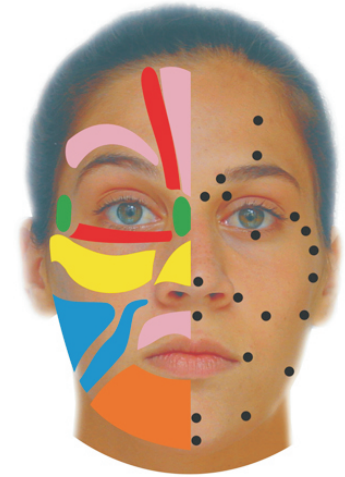

Facial Reflexology Sorensensistem™

was devised by Lone Sorensen, for whom it has won three honorary awards from the World Humanitarian Organisation for Health, Argentina. Over the past 30 years, she has been developing this powerful system of healing, drawing on acupuncture theory and traditional South American Indian practices and combining these with the stimulation of neurological points, to affect the whole body.

The facial zones are initially assessed to identify the primary imbalance or cause of symptoms disease. Treatment involves a range of techniques including the stimulation of acu-points and meridian zones, cranial points and zones, as well as specific nerve points chosen from 564 present in the face.

As with Foot or Hand Reflexology, the effects can be profound and far-reaching. Stimulation of the facial nerves provides a direct route to the brain. Lone has found that Facial Reflexology works very quickly into the central nervous system, has few contra-indications and is particularly beneficial for neurological disorders, including pain control. She continues to develop the therapy and has devised a range of additional techniques, including her highly regarded **Temprana therapy**, especially devised for children.

In Facial Reflexology, it is the condition of the underlying facial tissues that is read, to assess the condition of the body's energy systems. Fine lines and wrinkles, though, have their own place in reflecting our health. Lone continues to develop the therapy and has devised a range of special techniques, incorporating the use acupuncture points and natural oils on the face, to form a holistic and wonderfully effective face-lifting therapy which rejuvenates the facial tissues, thereby providing a natural and holistic beauty treatment.

Facial Reflexology is also especially relaxing and enjoyable to receive!

The Diploma in Facial Reflexology Sorensensistem™

is recognised by many associations in UK, including Association of Reflexologists (AoR), British Reflexology Association (BRA), Embody, BABTAC, Federation for Holistic Therapists, Irish Reflexologists' Institute, Independent Professional Therapists International (IPTI). The therapy is a powerful treatment in its own right and can also be used in conjunction with foot/ hand/ ear reflexology, body massage, and by therapists skilled as beauty therapists, acupuncturists, aromatherapists, chiropractors, dentists, doctors and osteopaths.

Tutors

Lone Sorensen is the originator of Facial Reflexology Sorensensistem™ and is a multi-disciplinary therapist. She studied reflexology and acupuncture in Denmark and has also studied in Chile, Cuba, France, Spain and Germany. She introduced Reflexology to Argentina, founding its first three schools. She currently teaches Facial Reflexology in many countries all over the world.

Angela Sellens Drake has been practising Reflexology for 25 years. She is Principal of Pathways School of Reflexology in UK, where she has run Professional and Advanced Training in Reflexology for 13 years. She has been working with Facial Reflexology since she met and trained with Lone Sorensen in 2003-4, and organised the first Facial Reflexology training courses in Norfolk, UK in 2007-8.

Parts 1 & 2 **26-29 March 2010 includes:**

- Background theory: Mapuche Indian and neurological techniques**
- assessment and diagnosis**
- the 7-step basic treatment**
- Meridianology and Five Element Theory**
- cranial points and zones**
- practising and developing the treatment**
- record keeping for facial reflexology; exam guidance**

Parts 3 & 4 **21-24 July include:**

- 564 neurological points**
- stimulation of facial muscles**
- cranial acupressure; intestinal links**
- treatment for childbirth/ labour**

Casework:

Guidance is given during Part 4 and by email following the course. The studies should be sent/ emailed to the tutors, normally within 3 months of the exam.
