

CAMP PROGRAM IN BRIEF

Limited places available for the camp cost €4,000 each. The cost includes therapy, accommodation and food for 1 parent and 1 child.

5.5 hours of therapy daily for 10 days, in the following allocation:

- **Primitive Reflexes Integration (2 hours daily)**
- **Temprana (2 hours daily)**
- **Speech Therapy (1 hour daily)**
- **Aquatic Therapy (30 min daily)**

- Every participant will receive a Temprana diagnosis, a Primitive Reflexes diagnosis and individualized home programs for all modalities of therapy received.

- **Dyslexia and Dyspraxia**

In this camp, we highly recommend parents/caregivers who are interested to learn the therapy themselves, to continue their work with their child at home, to join us.

WHAT IS PRIMITIVE REFLEXES INTEGRATION?

Babies are born with many physical, unconscious and involuntary responses, called primitive reflexes, that begun developing in utero.

Under normal circumstances, these primitive reflexes are integrated in a specific developmental sequence to eventually mature the central nervous system. The integration of these reflexes prepares the child for advanced motor skills and eventually learning readiness.

Many factors can interfere with this developmental process, including genetics, stress in pregnancy, birth trauma, and injury, etc.

When these reflexes are not fully integrated, the child can exhibit learning disorders, emotional and behavioural issues, gross and fine motor skill development delays, or sensory defensiveness.

The goal of the therapy is to integrate the retained primitive reflexes. Through working with the body and re-establishing the reflex patterns, we activate various parts of the brain, hence strengthening the whole body and brain integration process for the nervous system.
